RULES

- The Bird Hunt will be held on the Monday and Tuesday scheduled guided bird walks.
- The prize list is diminished as prizes are claimed.
- One prize per person per walk.
- Prizes are awarded to the first person sighting a prize species.
- Once a prize has been claimed no more prizes shall be awarded for that species.
- Participants are responsible for pointing out birds they see to the Guide.
- All sightings must be verified by the Guide.
- A competition entry fee of \$5.00 paid prior to each bird walk is required.
- No birds will be harmed in the hunt.
