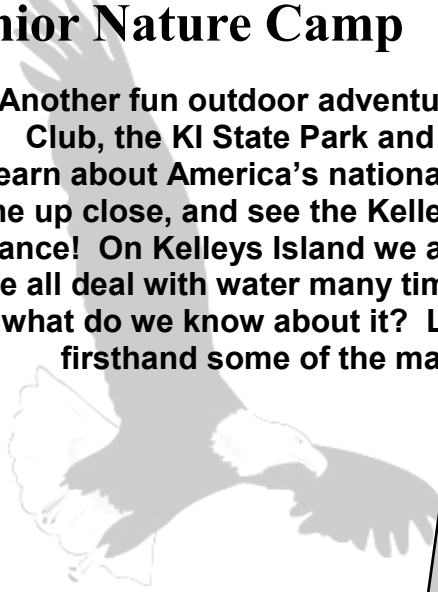




Kelleys Island Audubon Club Junior Nature Camp
